The Facts

- Carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gases have increased: 30% carbon dioxide and 30% carbon dioxide equivalents since about the time of the Industrial Revolution (mid-1800s).
- Global temperatures have increased 1.2 degrees Fahrenheit during approximately the same time period.
